Regional Māori Health Services

In Tauranga Hospital, we have the privilege of having the Regional Māori Health Services (RMHS) which provide a range of services, aiming to assist the Bay of Plenty District Health Board to reach high-need, at risk, communities. We are working towards increasing Māori for Māori services.

The paediatric outpatient RMHS clinics are run by 5 paediatric consultants and 1 senior paediatric registrar. There is also a clinical nurse and social worker on site. There is access to all external and internal services available to Tauranga Hospital and the BOPDHB. Location

Our RMHS is located within the hospital grounds, in the west wing of Silver Birch House. This site can be accessed via Clark street gate 4 with easy access to car parks directly adjacent to Silver Birch House

Paediatrics – what can you do?

We are aiming to improve the service provided to our tamariki (children) and are asking for your help when referring children to the paediatric outpatient department.

Any child of Māori descent is eligible to be seen in the RMHS outpatient clinic. We ask that you clarify the ethnicity of the child and inform the family of this service.
